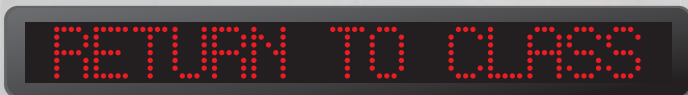
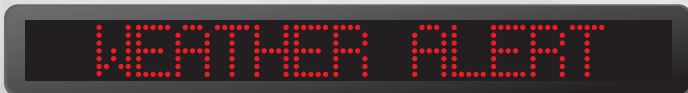


Emergency Displays

Telecor has developed a new notification feature further enhancing our systems for Emergency Communications. This new feature allows visual messages to be transmitted to marquee style displays in various locations in the school where large format displays are required. Gymnasiums, Cafeterias, Lobby Media Centers and Auditoriums can now display the same Emergency messages transmitted to our 2484 Calendar Clocks.

By default, the marquees will show the day of the week and time of day, followed by the date. Messages are initiated automatically from either the event schedule, manually from a Console, from an external contact closure or from a Visual Console. Messages can be displayed in a choice of colors. Available message colors are Green, Red, Yellow and Orange. Messages may be displayed with fixed, flashing or scrolling text up to 63 characters in length as set in the Telecor Editor.

Messages are encoded into clock protocol. With the addition of a PDD-1 Data Driver, the displays connect anywhere on the clock data buss.

Displays can be assigned to any of eight message zones throughout a facility. Each zone can be programmed to receive a different message.

Marquees also have the ability to display Emergency level calls that are initiated in the communications system. By displaying the origin of the call in common areas, staff situated closest to the call location can respond to critical situations quickly.
