

Telecor's Alarm Manager provides real time classroom status during a lockdown event in a school.

Occupants in locations designated as Shelter in Place, such as classrooms, can report their status directly to the front office or command center.

Responders can view the status of classrooms on a room-by-room basis, clearly displayed on a detailed facility floor map, using Telecor's Visual Console graphical user interface (GUI).

Classrooms receive pre-recorded messages according to the school's Emergency Response Plan with instructions on procedures during specific emergency situations.

The Alarm Manager also enables two-way communications between classroom locations and first responders, including features such as covert listen.
